FIRE PREPAREDNESS TIPS

1) Install and Maintain Smoke Detectors

Stay safe by placing a smoke detector outside of each sleeping area and every level of your home.

2) Plan Your Escape Route

Prepare by planning your escape route. Be sure that there are at least two ways to get out. Use the grid below to create the floor plan of your home to map out two escape routes in case there is a fire.

3) Practice Fire Drills

Anticipate your escape by practicing what to do in the event of a fire. Time your fire drill with the goal to get out in less than 2 minutes.

4) Decide Where to Meet

Plan a place for everyone in your home to safely meet outside.

5) Prepare for the Call

Fill out the important information below and keep in a visible place in the event of a fire.
