IMPORTANT UPDATES:

DECD CHANGES GUIDELINES FOR REAL ESTATE AS AN ESSENTIAL BUSINESS:

The guidelines, established by Maine's Department of Economic and Community Development, now require cloth face coverings in addition to foot coverings and gloves. All other guidelines remain unchanged. Read the updated Guidelines <u>here</u>.

MREC ALLOWS CASE-BY-CASE DEFERMENT OF CE REQUIREMENT:

During the ongoing state of emergency resulting from COVID-19, real estate licensees can request a deferment of the continuing education requirement for renewal of a license due to circumstances related to the emergency. If a request is approved, the continuing education requirement will be deferred for 120 days after the COVID-19 related state of emergency is terminated, at which time you will receive further instructions. The deferment request form must be completed and submitted prior to submitting the license renewal application. The request will be evaluated, and you will receive notification with instructions for completing the renewal process.
