In a press release to the media today, Maine home sales increased 28.32% comparing May 2021 to May 2020. The median sales price (MSP) was \$305,000, a 28.21% increase in that same time period. # CHEERS TO MAR! L.D. 192 BECOMES EFFECTIVE ON JUNE 29:

The Maine Legislature unanimously passed MAR's default road maintenance bill, sponsored by Senator Donna Bailey, and was signed by the Governor on March 17. The new law creates a statutory default for road maintenance responsibility on private roads when no other agreement is in place. As a result, the absence of a private road maintenance agreement

The First Special Session of the 130<sup>th</sup> Maine State Legislature commenced on April 28, 2021 and is ongoing.

# FHA UPDATES STUDENT LOAN PAYMENT CALCULATIONS:

On June 18, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) announced <u>updates</u> to its student loan monthly payment calculations to provide more access to affordable single family FHA-insured mortgage financing for creditworthy individuals with student loan debt. The updated policy more closely aligns FHA student loan debt calculation policies with other housing agencies. Changes become effective on or before August 16, 2021.
