

SALES DOWN AND VALUES UP IN AUGUST:

In a press release to the media today, Maine home sales decreased -4.76% comparing August 2021 to August 2020. The median sales price (MSP) was \$310,000, a 14.81% increase in that same time period. NAR reports that existing home sales were down and values were up nationally, and in the northeast, comparing August 2021 to August 2020.
