Fannie Mae has adopted the American National Standards Institute® (ANSI® Z765-2021) standard for measuring, calculating, and reporting gross living area (GLA) and non-gross living area (non-GLA) of subject properties. Compliance for delivery to Fannie Mae is required for all applicable appraisals with an effective date on or after April 1, 2022.
