REAL ESTATE LICENSE RENEWAL REMINDERS:

The Maine Real Estate Commission no longer mails license renewal reminders to you via the U.S. Postal Service. Renewal reminders are emailed to the email address that the Maine Real Estate Commission (not MAR) has on file for you. HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION:

The homestead exemption provides a reduction of up to \$25,000 in the value of a home for property tax purposes. To qualify, the applicant must be a permanent resident of Maine, the home must be the applicant's permanent residence, the applicant must have owned a home in Maine for the twelve months prior to applying, and an application must be filed on or before April 1 with the municipality where the property is located (only need to file once). The exemption applies to any residential property that is assessed as real property. Click here to learn more and share this link with your clients
