There will be lots of action in the Maine Senate and House over the next four weeks, MAR continues to track and work a number of high priority bills that have not reached their final resolution including such topics as rent stabilization (control), tenancy at will, local option sales tax, statewide residential rental unit registry, and more. There have been 2,007 legislative bills printed this session, and MAR is tracking just over 400 of those bills. Housing and real estate have been a major focus at the Maine State House!

LUPC AND STR'S:

The Land Use Planning Commission (LUPC) recently sent out a notice regarding their intent to study short term rental activity in the areas they service to determine potential regulatory options. The LUPC will be seeking feedback and will be hosting



in-person meetings over the next few months. Here is the STR website for reference.



MAINEHOUSING: PILOT PROGRAM:

Learn more about MaineHousing's new First Generation Program. The program is available for borrowers who have never lived in a home owned by their biological parents or legal guardians. The program is also available to borrowers who have been in foster care at some point in their childhood. MAINE PAINT STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM:

Maine's Paint Stewardship Law requires that the paint manufacturing industry develop a financially sustainable and environmentally responsible program to recycle leftover paints, stains, and varnish. PaintCare is the program set up in Maine and accepts all brands of paint, stains and varnish – even if they are 20 years old! All PaintCare sites accept up to 5 gallons per visit, but some sites accept more.
