There will be lots of activity in the Maine Senate and House over the next three weeks, MAR continues to track and work several high priority bills that have not reached their final resolutions. There have been 2,009 legislative bills printed this session, and MAR is tracking 412 of those bills

MAR will be launching a Call for Action on Monday regarding LD 804 "An Act to Increase the Time Period for Notice to Terminate a Tenancy at Will."
